INFORMATION FOR EXAMINATION CANDIDATES

Assessment of applications:

Applicants for examination will be assessed as meeting the pre-examination requirements specified by the International Institute of Welding (IIW) and AS 2214. It is essential that the examination application form be fully and correctly completed by all applicants.

Examination prerequisites are:

1. For IIW WT1 - satisfactory completion of the WT1 Welding Supervisor Course including Distance Learning component.
2. For AS 2214 - documentary evidence of having one of the following:
 - (a) Three years approved practical experience in the fabrication engineering industry, and successful completion of an approved course that includes.
 - (i) welding process technology;
 - (ii) welding metallurgy;
 - (iii) weld testing and inspection; and
 - (iv) Standards and specifications.
 - (b) Three years approved experience in the supervision or inspection of welding.
 - (c) A qualification in either engineering, metallurgy or welding, and three years approved experience related to the practical application of welding.

If you have not supplied the required documentation with your WT1 Welding Supervisor Course application this examination application will not proceed until you have demonstrated that you meet these requirements.

Examinations:

Locations for the examinations:

Locations for the examinations will depend on the number of applications received from each location. Successful applicants will be advised of the venue two weeks prior to the examinations.

Results:

Each Candidate will be notified by email of the marks awarded for each paper and the result, that is, PASS or FAIL. The results will be posted to the candidate within eight weeks after the examinations have been sat.

Fees:

The examination fee payable is noted in this application form. Fees shall be paid before the examination.
